Legacy Policy

At Holy Trinity, Washington, we welcome all gifts in Wills, however large or small, and we promise to use your gift to make a difference in our parish. Our PCC legacy policy is **to use gifts to help fund significant development projects, whether to do with the building, mission, ministry or equipment.**

Since needs change over the years, we encourage donors to leave a gift in their Will for the general purposes of the parish rather than for a restricted purpose. We will discuss possible uses of a gift with executors when the time comes, bearing in mind the donor's known areas of interest in the church (e.g. music, building, mission etc.) and the church's priorities at the time.

Donors can be confident that any gift will be used to make a real difference to **our future mission and ministry.**

As far as is allowed by law we will acknowledge gifts in whatever way the donor and/or his/her executors feel most appropriate. Equally we can make sure that gifts remain anonymous if the donor prefers.

If anyone wishes to talk to someone, in confidence, about any aspect of leaving a legacy please he/she should speak to either the Rector or the Church Treasurer.

The PCC also welcomes any gift to the church in memoriam of a loved one and would be glad to discuss an appropriate project with the donor. The PCC considers this to be a wonderful and appropriate way to remember a loved one.
